Classes 1 2 3 & 4 Optimum Time over whole course (all include water crossing with a number of alternative fences available)

CLASS 1 Novice Approx 35-50cm Rosettes to 6th place

CLASS 2 Intermediate Pairs Approx 75cm Rosettes to 3rd place

CLASS 3 Intermediate Approx 75cm Rosettes to 6th place
*Qualifier for Eland Lodge 70cm

CLASS 4 Open Approx 90cm Rosettes to 6th place
*Qualifier for Eland Lodge 80cm

CONDITIONS

1. Entry fees will only be refunded, less admin, if the event is cancelled due to weather and if we are unable to reschedule.
2. The organisers, officials, helpers and landowner cannot accept any liability for accidents, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
3. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the course or any class if considered necessary.
4. Medical armbands compulsory, properly filled in, to be worn on arm only. Body protectors Level 3 2018 or after blue label & a skull cap or hat with safety harness & no fixed peak according to VG1 01.040 (2014-12), EN1384 (2023), ASTM F1163, SNELL E2016 or 2021, or PAS015 (2011) or higher must be worn by all competitors or riders, and long hair to be tied up.
5. No stopwatches, mobile phones or cameras on horse or rider on course.
6. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any officials must be obeyed.
7. The judges' decision is final.
8. Horse or pony must be 4 years old or over. No horse or pony may compete more than once in each class.
9. The fence judges and other officials reserve the right to withdraw any horse / pony that, in their opinion, is not fit to compete. Fall of horse or rider now incurs elimination.
10. This Hunter Trial will be run under the prevailing British Riding Club Rules. Please also refer to the course map.
11. Passports must be shown to secretary before collecting numbers showing horses are within annual vaccination period.
12. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
13. Acceptance of these conditions as to liability shall be a condition of entry or participation in this competition.
